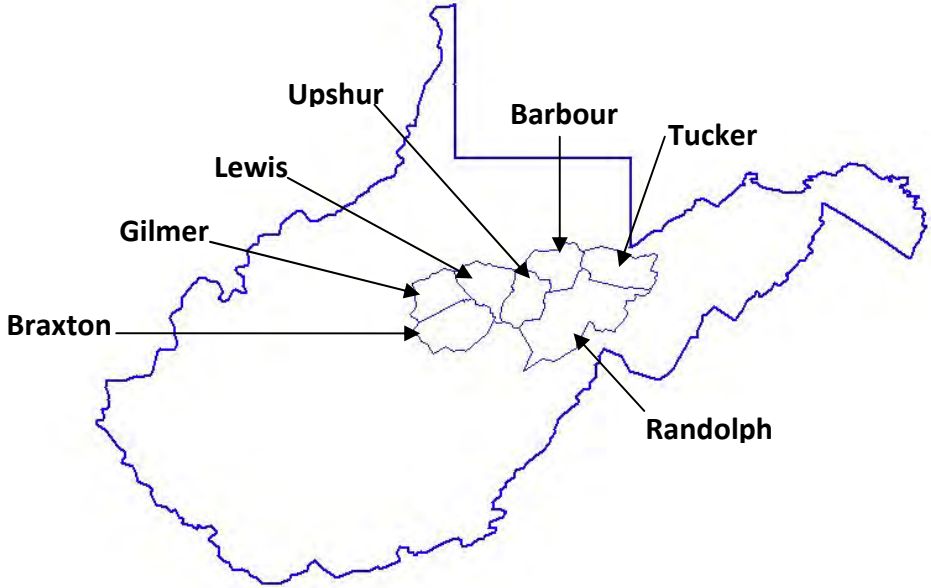

Heavy Snows / Heavy Rains

Heavy precipitation occurs in the eastern sections of Region VII. The highest average annual rainfall in West Virginia is recorded at Pickens in Randolph County.

Drought can occur in the extreme east, both precipitation climates are caused by orographic lifting.

For the most part, all the precipitation that occurs in the east drains through the western counties making them prone to flooding.
